Probably nothing. The King's Indian Defense has a well-deserved reputation of spectacular battles often terminated with a massacre on White's kingside castle. The philosophy behind this defense has always been the same, black plays a kingside fianchetto regardless of what white plays and then he attacks the center and depending on what kind of pawn structure arises black will attack one flank or the other, but the goal is the same black plays for the mate!

The Four Pawns Attack in the King's Indian Defence is a chess opening that begins with the moves: 1. d4 Nf6 2. c4 g6 3. Nc3 Bg7 4. e4 d6 5. f4 White immediately builds up a large pawn centre in order to gain a spatial advantage. Black first develops his pieces, then tries to attack White's centre by means of the pawn advances...e7–e5,...c7–c5 or...f7–f5, depending on circumstances. This formation has never attracted serious interest in high-level play, although Alexander Alekhine used ...
