Load a file with configuration options that will be added to the command-line options. Note that the order is important. For example, if we have a config.txt file that contains -c'clock 1000 and we specify command line -c'clock 1100 -config config.txt, the options from the config.txt file will take precedence and the resulting -c'clock will be 1000.
